<p>EQUIS European Foundation for Management Development</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ european accreditation organization for Business Schools ➤ requires at least 25 full time faculty members ➤ has already accredited about 80 Business Schools worldwide ➤ process oriented validation
